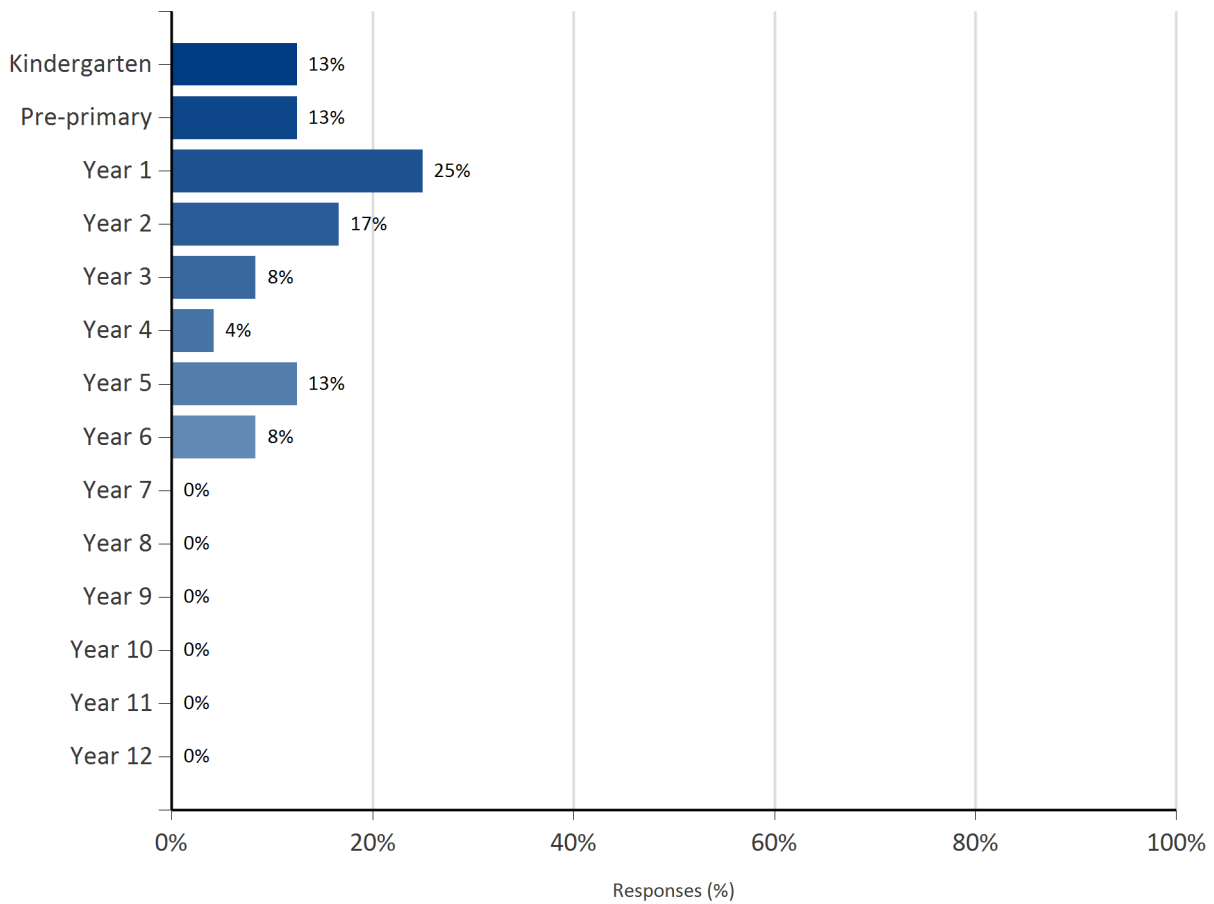

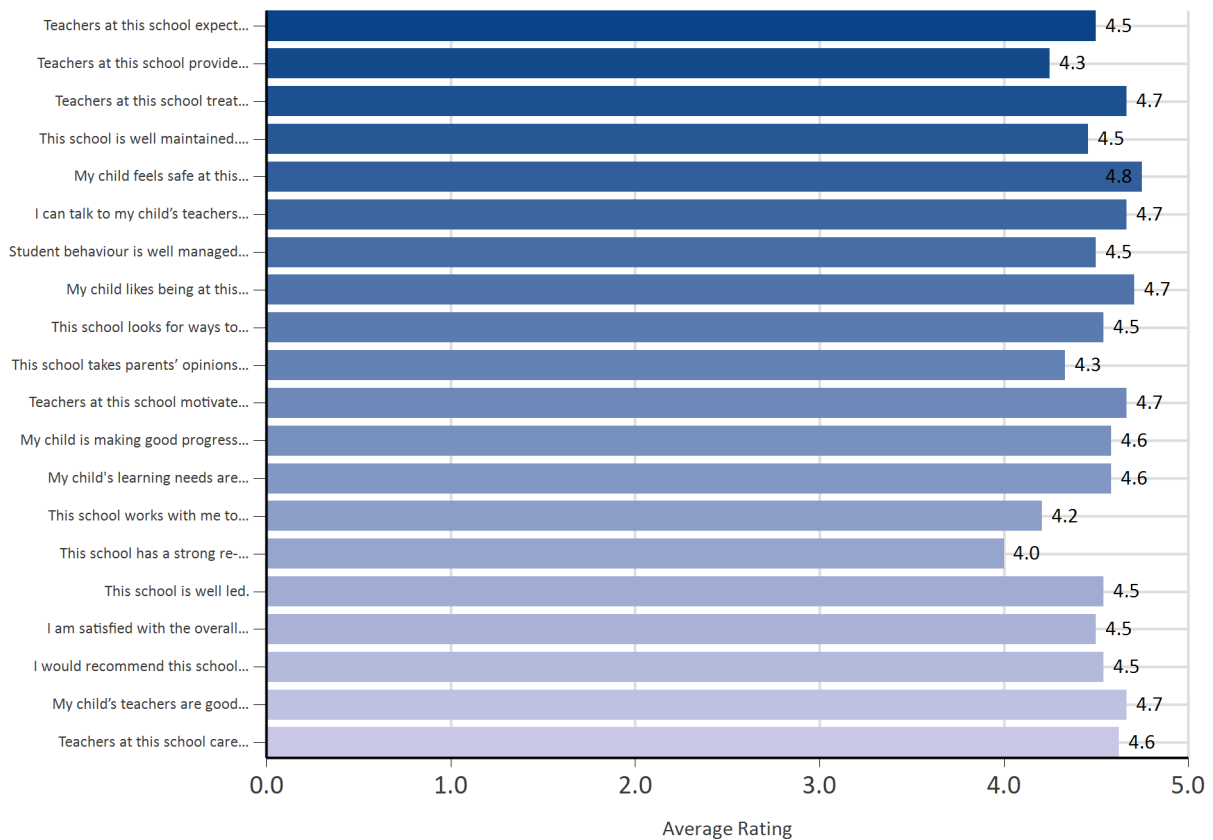

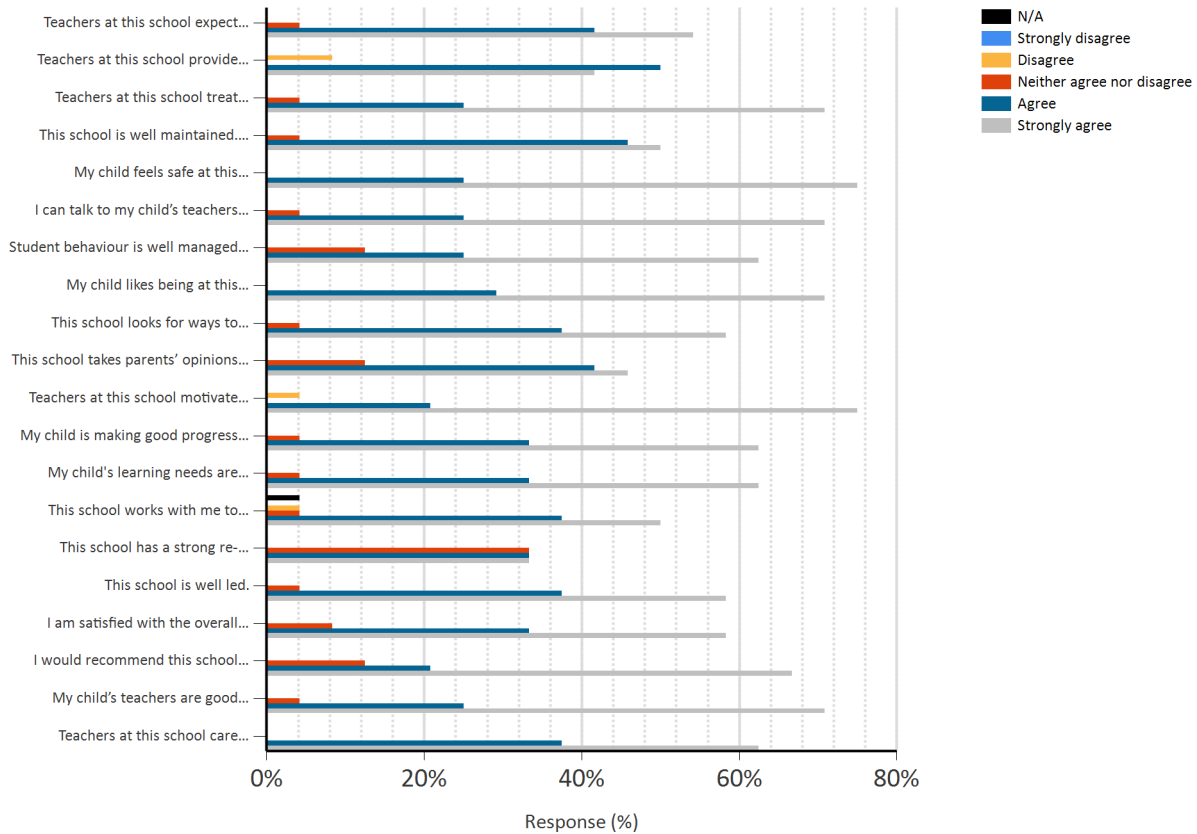

Not specific to improvement, but somehow correlated. Explore the possibility of continuity of having the class class teacher teaching year 5 this year to teach to same students in year six in 2019. This is allow the students perform better at a crucial exit stage from their primary schools. Thank you.
- More emphasis on academics and while important, less emphasis on recreational activities. - More discipline around learning and motivating Students to learn. - More emphasis on "manual" learning and encouraging Students to think for themselves rather than relying on hints from having technological assistance. - More Parent and Teacher interactions in regards to Student's learning and development. For example Parents would welcome a Parent and Teacher Open Day, similar to the Class/School Open Day in the afternoon/evening. It will make interactions less formal to scheduling a meeting, and both party more open for free discussions. - Regular Teacher to Parent feedback specific to the Child in regards to current work at School, positives and areas for improvement, so that "issues" are caught early and Parents can focus on key learning areas at home, before the end of term Report is due.
How to discipline kids who display disrespectful behaviour. Second language teaching needs to engage the kids more. Toilet hygiene education among the students.
School structure renovations/repaint Need more days for kindagarden students
Classroom sizes - some of the classes are getting pretty close to 30 kids. The covered area is great and it would be good to be able to utilise this space more for class performances etc by adding a stage or raised component.
Having a real community feeling in and out of school, having more activities with the school and the families so this "community feeling" can be developed (camping night at the school, movie night, fair day, talent show etc.) We need to have better results and compare our school to the school around us. We need to take care of the image of the school by, for example, caring about our verge, fences...

I really think that Italian is not the best choice for language teaching and would much prefer a language related our region, such as Japanese, Mandarin, or Korean.
I would like to see the school invest in a better PA system and wireless microphone for presentations, assemblies etc.
Please get a step stool for the smaller children to stand on behind the podium when they are speaking.
The end of year concert is so great but I feel it is too crowded for the current space, and not enough chairs. It would be good to use some kind of community partner with a more appropriately sized venue.
More parent involvement needs to be encouraged.
Perhaps there could be a stronger emphasis on recycling and sustainability.
I am concerned about school banking in the light of recent news reports concerning the ethics of such programmes and feel the school could find other ways to encourage learning about good saving habits.
